



DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1: Nairobi. Arrive in Nairobi, Kenya where you will be met and escorted to the Gymkhana for overnight. A welcome safari briefing by your Wildlife Safari manager. Nairobi Gymkhana for overnight

Day 2. Full day in Nairobi with visits to Daphne Sheldrick Orphanage, Giraffe Centre, Karen Blixen Museum and finally shopping before transfer to Gymkhana for overnight

Day 3: Amboseli. Breakfast and drive to the Amboseli Game Reserve arriving for lunch at the Amboseli Sopa Lodge, your luxury safari lodge, facing the snowcapped summit of Kilimanjaro, Africa's highest mountain. Enjoy your first game drive in the Amboseli Game Reserve looking for herds of elephant and other wildlife species. *Amboseli Sopa Lodge*

Day 4: Amboseli. A dawn game viewing drive just as the sun rises over Kilimanjaro. Return to your lodge for a late breakfast and spend the rest of the morning relaxing by the swimming Pool. Another game viewing drive late this afternoon around the lakes and springs fed by the melting snows of Kilimanjaro, home to a multitude of bird and animal species. Amboseli is also well known for its large herds of elephant. You will also be invited to plant your own acacia tree in "The Amboseli Reforestation" project established by Wildlife Safari. Enjoy a special dinner "under the stars" this evening at your safari lodge. *Amboseli Sopa Lodge*

Day 5 -Depart Amboseli after breakfast and drive to Tsavo West National Park arriving at your safari lodge in time for lunch. Kilaguni Serena Lodge features a thatched central dining area and a rock-built bar, with a viewing terrace looking directly down on to the waterhole where animals come to drink water. Enjoy an afternoon game drive and visit the Mzima Springs, with its unique underwater hippo observatory, Return to the lodge for dinner and overnight.

Day 6 –Morning and afternoon game viewing drive in Tsavo West National Park
Meals and overnight at Kilaguni Serena Safari Lodge.

Day 7 – Nairobi

Breakfast ,depart and drive along the Mombasa / Nairobi highway towards Nairobi.
Drop off at Nairobi Gymkhana.

Day 8 – Masai Mara

Early morning pick up from Gymkhana and drive to the Masai Mara Game Reserve where almost immediately, you are surrounded by wildlife as you game view on the vast savannah grasslands as you drive towards your safari lodge. Perched on the summit of a hill overlooking the rivers and plains below, and ideally located in the wildlife rich area, your safari lodge has been designed in the form of a traditional Masai “manyatta” or village and every room has sweeping views. There is also a swimming pool and one of the better boutiques on safari in the country. Lunch and late afternoon game viewing drive in the Masai Mara, before returning to your lodge for dinner.
Overnight – Mara Leisure Lodge

Day 9 – Masai Mara

Enjoy a full day of game viewing in the Masai Mara following wildebeest, zebra, gazelle, eland, topi, impala and other plains species. The big cats, lion, leopard and cheetah are found in greater concentrations than anywhere else and looking to pounce, if the opportunity arises. Herds of giraffe and elephant create a magical silhouette against the treeless savannah while hippo and crocodile happily frolic in the Mara and Talek rivers. Your Wildlife Safari guide may suggest an extended game viewing drive, travelling much further away from other vehicles and visitors, with a special picnic lunch from your safari lodge.

Overnights – Mara Leisure Lodge

Depart after breakfast and drive leisurely through the reserve and later on back to Nairobi arriving in the late afternoon. Your guide will drop you off at either the airport or at Gymkhana
